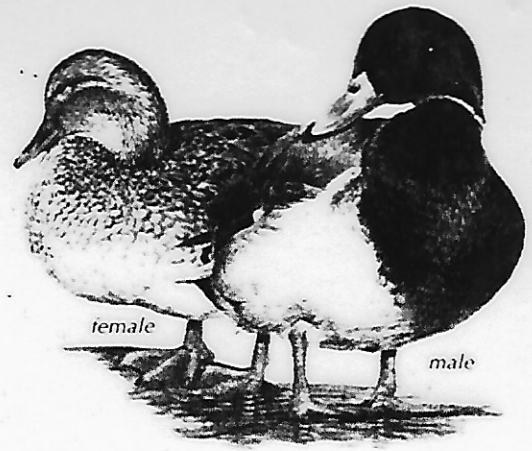


MALLARD

Anas platyrhynchos

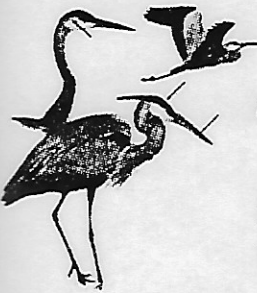


Common in open areas by lakes and ponds and in wetlands. The webbed foot has three long toes that all point forward. The inward pointing feet give the Mallard a pigeon toed appearance.

Tracks usually found in mud of freshwater and salt marshes and along shores of bays, estuaries, lakes, and rivers. Stalks and eats fish, frogs, snakes, and small mammals. Usually nests in colonies.
