

## Fall 2020 Discover the Flyway Teacher Introduction to Virtual Programs

### Live, Virtual Learning Activities

#### Reservations, Schedule, and Fees

- Reservations are currently being taken through December 2020 only.
- Scheduling will be as flexible as possible depending on teachers' needs and staff schedules.
- Four learning activity time slots will be available per day: 9:00 am, 10:00 am, 11:00 am, 1:00 pm; Again, we will work with teachers and adjust times to the best of our ability if the suggested time slots do not work with remote teaching schedules.
- A virtual Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area tour will be offered at 1:00 pm only to allow staff and docents travel time to the Wildlife Area. The 1:00 pm time slot is not required to be Wildlife Area tour. It can also be reserved for a learning activity; first come, first served.
- Live, virtual learning activities will be scheduled for 40 minutes.
- Programs are intended for **one class** at a time.
- Flat fee: \$75 for the first learning activity and \$50 for each additional learning activity.
- The "What is a Wetland Introduction", a recorded introduction to wetlands, is available free with the reservation of a learning activity.

- Hands-on Materials
  - Some virtual learning activities will require hands-on materials.
  - All required materials, with the exception of Owl Pellets, are included in the flat fee for the activity. (Owl Pellets are an additional \$2.00 per student fee if provided by Yolo Basin Foundation.)
  - Teachers have the option of providing the materials themselves or putting them on a list of required supplies for students.
  - Materials must be requested in advance and can be picked up at Yolo Basin Foundation. In special cases, materials can be delivered (to one location within a 15 – 20 mile radius of Yolo Basin Foundation) by a staff member or volunteer. Some materials may be mailed and will include additional fees for postage.
