



Discover the Flyway **2025-26 Terms and Conditions**

Program Reservations

All reservations are made on a first come, first served basis on Yolo Basin Foundation's website. To start the reservation process, select an available date for the program type you would like to reserve and complete a registration form. A separate registration form is required for each program. After submitting a registration form, you will receive an auto generated acknowledgement followed by a confirmation email. Keep the confirmation for your records.

Cancellations

If you need to cancel your reservation, notify us as soon as possible and **at least two weeks before** your scheduled program. Rescheduling a canceled reservation is based on availability and is not guaranteed.

In severe or unsafe conditions, Yolo Basin Foundation may be required to cancel a program. Fall *Discover the Flyway in the Wildlife Area* field trips (October through December 2025) take place from start to finish outdoors in the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area without protection from the elements and are subject to cancellation at short notice due to weather conditions. Every effort will be made to reschedule a canceled program. In the event Yolo Basin Foundation cancels a program and is not able to reschedule, we will refund any payment that has been made.

Group Size

Discover the Flyway field trips and Vernal Pool-based field trips: minimum 15 students; maximum 30 students (Fall 2025) 40 students (Winter and Spring 2026); *Discover the Flyway* In-class Activities: one class with a maximum of 34 students per presentation

Supervision

All Programs: The teacher is responsible for supervision and must remain with students at all times. On field trips, a minimum of one chaperone is required for each station selected. Chaperones are expected to assist with student management and must remain with their assigned students at all times. Chaperones must accompany students to the restrooms. No siblings are allowed.

Weather

Discover the Flyway field trips take place outdoors, rain or shine. In-class Activities can also take place outdoors. Be prepared and dress appropriately for the weather.

Teacher Workshop: Teachers are required to attend a one-time Teacher Workshop before bringing their students on a *Discover the Flyway* Field Trip or *Discover the Flyway* Vernal Pool-based Field Trip.
