**Program Reservations**

All reservations are made on a first come, first served basis through the Yolo Basin Foundation website. To begin the reservation process, select an available date for your desired program and complete the registration form. A separate registration form is required for each program.

After submitting your registration form, you will receive an auto-generated acknowledgement email followed by a confirmation email. **Please keep the confirmation email for your records.**

**Invoices**

An invoice will be emailed to the person making the reservation after the registration form is submitted. Payments can be made by check, credit card, or cash.

### **Cancellations**

If you need to cancel your reservation, please notify us as soon as possible and no later than **two weeks** prior to your scheduled program. Rescheduling a canceled reservation is based on availability and is not guaranteed.

Yolo Basin Foundation reserves the right to cancel programs due to severe or unsafe conditions. All *Discover the Flyway* field trips take place entirely outdoors, at both the demonstration wetlands and the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area or other tour location, with limited or no access to indoor shelter. As a result, programs may be canceled on short notice due to weather or site conditions.

Every effort will be made to reschedule canceled programs. If a program cannot be rescheduled, any payments made will be refunded.

### **Refunds**

All refunds issued due to cancellation on behalf of the registrant are subject to a \$10 administrative fee. No refunds will be provided for programs canceled within 14 days of the program start date.

### **Weather**

As mentioned, *Discover the Flyway* field trips take place outdoors, rain or shine. In-class Activities may also take place outdoors. Participants should come prepared and dress appropriately for weather conditions.

### **Alternate Tour Locations**

During the winter months, portions or the entirety of the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area may be periodically closed due to flooding. In the event of the YBWA being closed on the day of your scheduled field trip, your class will be guided on a tour of an alternate site, South Fork Preserve.



## **Group Size**

Group size requirements vary by program and are outlined below

### ***Discover the Flyway* Field Trips and Vernal Pool-based Field Trips**

- Minimum: 15 students
- Maximum: 30 students (if choosing 3 activities); 40 students (if choosing 3 or 4 activities)

### ***Discover the Flyway* In-Class Activities**

- One class per presentation
- Maximum of 34 students per presentation

## **Supervision**

For both In-class Activities and field trips, teachers are responsible for student supervision at all times and must remain with their students throughout the program. For field trips, a minimum of one chaperone is required for each selected station. Chaperones are expected to assist with student management and must remain with their assigned group at all times, including accompanying students to the restrooms, as needed. Siblings are not permitted.

## **Teacher Workshop**

All educators bringing a class on a *Discover the Flyway* field trip are required to attend a Teacher Workshop prior to their scheduled field trip. This requirement applies even if attending with another teacher who has previously completed the workshop. The workshop is a one-time requirement.

Educators may reserve a field trip prior to attending a workshop but must complete the workshop before the scheduled program date. Find more information on teacher workshops [here](#).
